ELIGIBILITY

ACEC-NH member firms engaged in the practice of consulting engineering in New Hampshire are eligible to enter the awards competition.

- Firms may obtain permission from the client/owner prior to submittal.
- Projects must be substantially completed or publicly disclosed by the client for use between November 1, 2017 and October 31, 2019.
- A firm may submit multiple entries.
- Sub-consultants are eligible to submit, provided they coordinate with the prime consultant and all team members.

Each Additional Firm in Entry:	\$ 100

RATING GUIDELINES

Each entry will be evaluated based upon the following criteria:

- Uniqueness and/or innovative application of techniques
- Future value to the engineering profession and enhanced public awareness
- Social, economic, and sustainable development considerations
- Complexity
- Successful fulfillment of client/owner needs

Describe in layman's terms why this project is worthy of special recognition (100-500 word count) addressing factors that highlight the above criteria.
